Fans of Haitian-American violinist Daniel Bernard Roumain can witness his incredible talent live in his new orchestral epic, **Darwin's Meditation for the People of Lincoln**. The production, derived from Roumain's discovery that Lincoln and Darwin were both born on February 12, 1809, features an imagined conversation between the pair, who shared an aversion to enslavement. Laced with Roumain's sounds of Haiti invoking the country's own struggle for liberty and punctuated by words recited by actor Daniel Beaty, the work is a sonic vision of freedom.
